Dear Ms. Jeffery:

I am writing to advise you that the Canadian Association of University Teachers has established an Ad Hoc Investigatory Committee to examine the situation at the Atlantic Veterinary College at your university.

The terms of reference for the Ad Hoc Investigatory Committee are to:

- Examine allegations of:
 - Improper procedural practices in investigations of faculty members' behaviour;
 - o Disregard of collegial decision-making;
 - o Irregular hiring procedures;
 - o Inequities in clinical service workload;
 - o Inadequate handling of relations between technicians and faculty;
 - Lack of clarity in terms of the roles and responsibilities of technicians and faculty; and
 - o Low morale resulting from unresolved tensions between the faculty and the administration.
- Consider other issues that may arise in the course of its investigation;
- Make any appropriate recommendations.

The operative section for ad hoc investigatory committees is Section 6.

The Committee will be contacting you in due course to explain the issues of concern and gather relevant documentation so that it can get a full and fair understanding of the facts. We hope the UPEIFA will assist the committee as necessary.
